

**Research Consultant / Research Associate Policy, Guidelines and Selection Process**

**1. Background**

The Government of Karnataka established the Fiscal Policy Institute in 2007. The setting up of FPI signifies the commitment of the State to institutionalize the process of implementing the Karnataka Fiscal Responsibility Act, 2002 in letter and spirit.

**2. Vision**

The resources invested through FPI enhance quality of human capital engaged in public service delivery, the outcome of which enhances their efficiency, promotes a habit of adherence to macro-prudential fiscal norms and ensures value for money to citizens for all time.

The intrinsic objective of FPI is to provide integrated solutions to problems, including the design, implementation, monitoring and evaluation relating to public resource use. The Institute functions under the administrative control of Finance Department. FPI's activities as a training enterprise are being delivered through its five Centres:

- a) Public Resource Management
- b) Public Expenditure Management
- c) Financial Accountability and Decentralization
- d) Planning, IT and Statistics
- e) Project Management

**3. Key Activities of FPI assigned by the Government:**

1. To provide structured training and research programs for Government Officers/officials on various aspects of financial planning, administration and management.
2. To provide the necessary physical infrastructure and managerial resources to facilitate such training and research on an ongoing basis.
3. To develop best practices in governance in the cases of Fiscal Finance.
4. To take up specialised research and studies of immediate advantage to the State.
5. To advice and support Finance Department on following areas;
  - Tax Policy Analysis and Resource Forecasting
  - Expenditure Planning, Analysis and Project evaluation
  - Debt Management
  - Fiscal Decentralisation

- Information Systems Support
- Specific inputs for budget supportive documents
- Training modules for Finance Department staff.

**Activities carried out by FPI at present:**

Training Related:

- a. Design customized training modules for training Group 'A' and 'B' officers of various Govt. of Karnataka Departments and PSUs.
- b. Conduct training programmes, Symposium, Conferences in collaboration with Govt. of Karnataka Departments and PSUs.

Research Related:

- a) Provide policy-relevant data and insight to Finance Department by Economic Analysis Cell on selected Agricultural Commodities for Karnataka by reviewing trends in prices and arrivals for eleven commodities by comparing the same with prices at three levels i.e., All-India, Regional, and District.
- b) Associate with Budget Section of Finance Department in preparing Gender Budget of the State by Gender Budget Cell.
- c) Provide support to PMU, FD by Debt Management and Financial Analysis Cell.

Projects:

- a) 'Reinforcing the Missing Link in Gender Responsive Budgeting' Project offered by UN Women has been taken up by FPI.

**4. The Concept of Research Consultancy/Research Association:**

One of the main objective of FPI is to take up specialised research studies of immediate and long term relevance to Government and Public Sector entities on demand and also suomoto.

Research Consultancy/Research Association is an option for persons who have done/doing their Ph.D., published Research papers, to gain exposure to fiscal and financial issues related to Government and to analyse the trend and policies. The ideas and experiences which Research Consultants/ Research Associates will add value to the research related output and projects at FPI and / or strengthen the capacity of FPI in designing and developing training modules. Research and analysis reports would help the Government to take valuable decisions and in policy making. Research and Analysis are the major activities to be strengthened.

In order to support the Faculty of FPI who are engaged in training, research and consultancy activities, a proposal to hire Research Consultants as against 5 sanctioned posts of Special Officers was moved and got approved by the Additional Chief Secretary and Chairman, Governing Council on 06/08/2012

vide note sheet para 6 of file no. FPI/FPAC/92/12-13.

The FPI organogram (revised) proposal also make provision for hiring 5 Research Consultants/ Research Associates. The Chairman, FPI Governing Council has approved to incorporate the parameters proposed for selection of Research Consultants/ Research Associates vide note sheet para 4 of file no. FPI/Adm/26/2014 dated 24/08/2016. Further vide para 4 of file no. FPI/E/07/16-17 has approved to make provision to take Research Consultants/Research Associates on deputation also.

The Research Consultants/ Research Associates are required to compile and manage data, prepare documents, involve in writing reports, engaged in statistical analysis, coordinate training activities, development of finance modules, website management etc...

**5. Objective of FPI's Research Consultant/ Research Associate appointment:**

The purpose of Research Consultant / Research Associate appointment is:

- a) To lend support to various studies being undertaken by FPI in areas related to fiscal issues and institutional management aspects;
- b) To provide academic inputs to FPI's research activities;
- c) To support FPI Faculty in training activities;
- d) To provide scope for insight into practical application of fiscal issues, public sector activities in financial areas and to learn from case studies;

**6. Eligibility:**

**I. Research Consultants:**

- a) Applicant's age should be more than 18 and less than 40 years.
- b) Applicant should be a post graduate degree in Economics in any area of specialisation or Business Management or Commerce or Statistics, Information Technology, Human Resources, Public Administration with minimum 60% of marks from any recognised University.
- c) Applicants should have Ph.D./ M.Phil. qualification or should be pursuing Ph.D.
- d) Applicants should have Research experience of at least 2 years.
- e) Applicants having experience in using computers especially in MS office and having additional qualification are preferred.
- f) Applicants having teaching experience and proficiency in data analysis techniques are preferred.
