Sub : Calling for applications to the posts of
Research Fellows / Research Associates in
Fiscal Policy Institute.

Applications are invited from eligible candidates for appointment on contract basis for a period of one year to the posts of Research Fellows / Research Associates with post graduate degree in Economics in any area of specialization or Business Management or Commerce or Statistics or Information Technology or Human Resources or Public Administration expertise.

Profile of the Fiscal Policy Institute: The Institute was set up by the Govt. of Karnataka in the year 2007 with the support from the Planning Commission and functioning under the Finance Department. The key objectives of the FPI are to provide training to public officials in fiscal policy issues and operations, providing systematic support relating to public Financial Management (PFM) with focus on state, national and local bodies' finances. Further, research and consultancy in the relevant field also expected from FPI.

Job Requirements: The Research Fellows / Research Associates will be supporting the faculty of FPI who are engaged in training, research and consultancy activities. The selected candidates inter – alia are required to compile and manage data, prepare documents, involve in writing reports, engage in statistical analysis, co-ordinate training activities, development of finance modules, web-site management etc. The job may also require travelling outside Bengaluru, subject to normal allowances.

Note: If any of the candidates want to pursue higher studies, specialized studies in the above subjects, they will be encouraged to do while balancing their work on hand.

Eligibility:

I. Research Fellow:

Age: Age of the candidates shall be less than 40 years as on 01.11.2018.

Educational Qualification:

- a) Applicant should have a post graduate degree in Economics or Business Management or Commerce or Statistics or Information Technology or Human Resources or Public Administration with aggregate 60% marks or equivalent grade from any University / Institution recognized by UGC.
- b) Applicant should have Ph.D or M.Phil qualification or should be pursuing Ph.D.
- c) Applicant should have research experience of at-least 2 years.
- d) The candidates having, experience in using computers especially in MS Office, any additional qualifications, teaching experience and proficiency in data analysis techniques shall be preferred.
- e) Publications in areas of specialization in refereed journals.
- f) Preference shall be given to candidates having specialization in specific area in which FPI undertakes Research/Training/Consultancy.

II. Research Associates:

Age: Age of the candidates shall be less than 40 years as on 01.11.2018.


Educational Qualification:

- a) Applicant should have a post graduate degree in Economics or Business Management or Financial Management or Commerce or Statistics or Information Technology or Human Resources or Public Administration with aggregate 55% marks or equivalent grade from any University / Institute recognised by UGC.
- b) Applicants who have published Research papers shall be preferred.
- c) The candidates having experience in using computers especially in MS Office & any additional qualifications shall be preferred.
- d) Preference shall be given to candidates having specialization in specific area in which FPI undertakes Research/Training/Consultancy.

Consolidated Remuneration: It ranges between Rs. 24,000/- to Rs. 45,000/- per month depending upon the qualification and experience of the candidate and the position offered.

How to apply and general conditions:

- a) Eligible candidates should send their application in the prescribed format which is available on FPI web site indicating details of name, age, gender, language proficiency (reading, writing and speaking), educational qualification (indicating grades with subjects and university, year of passing etc), work experience, research experience, contact phone number (mobile and land line), email address, latest two academic reference addresses and contact number with e-mail Id or a reference from previous or present employer.
- b) Eligible applicants are required to submit their applications in the prescribed format available on FPI website to the Director, Fiscal Policy Institute, either in person or through post or through e-mail to jointdirector@fpibangalore.gov.in, on or before 05.01.2019. Delayed applications will not be considered. The interested eligible candidates from government service may also apply for the Research Fellow / Research Associate post through proper channel to reach within the prescribed date above.
- c) The short – listed eligible candidates will be intimated by e-mail to attend a written test and interview **at FPI office, Kengeri Post, Bengaluru-Mysore Road, Kengeri, Near Panchamukhi Ganapathi Temple, Bengaluru-560 060.**
- d) The selected candidates will be subject to medical fitness and also subject to entering into an agreement of terms and conditions with FPI to work in the institute for a minimum period of one year and also subject to satisfactory output, reviewed quarterly.
- e) The terms and conditions of contract will be as applicable under the provisions of Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules and general guidelines issues by Government from time to time.
